Dear Resident:

The first phase of the Capitol City Golf Course Water & Wastewater project has been awarded to South Sound Contractors of Lacey, WA Construction, and they are scheduled to begin on May 11th 2020 and anticipated to be complete in summer of 2021. Please see the attached Frequently Asked Questions and Project Map showing the construction that is included in the first phase of this project.

While the current state of the COVID-19 pandemic in our State has created a forecast of uncertainty, we anticipate that the Contractor performing the work will be able to proceed with the intended construction schedule. This project is considered essential public infrastructure and construction will not be put on hold. In an effort to limit any interaction between the construction crews and the general public, we are asking that you call the City inspector if you have any questions or concerns. Please do not approach the construction crews or City inspector if possible, and if you must speak in person please follow the recommended 6-ft distancing guidelines.

Please be aware that while access to your homes will be maintained, there will be times when construction may limit access or cause delays. For everyone's safety please use alternate routes around construction zones whenever possible.
